

**CS (MA) Rules 1944 — Renewal of name of the AMA for the
treatment of Central Government Employees and Members of
their family for the period from 1-8-2013 to 31-7-2014**

In terms of Ministry of Health and Family Planning's (Department of Health) instructions contained in O.M. No. 9-14025/133/79-MS, dated 28-5-1982 and C & A.G. Circular No. 445-Audit/17/87/III-90 (86), dated 10-8-1990 and as per Rule 2-A (iv) of the CS (MA) Rules 1944, the name of the following Private Medical Practitioners are renewed as Authorized Medical Attendant during the normal working hours for the treatment of the Central Government Employees and members of their family stationed at or passing through Kolkata and its adjoining Municipalities (as shown against each AMA) which are not covered by CGHS for a period of one year i.e. from 1-8-2013 to 31-7-2014.

**(IMPORTANT NOTE FOR THE AMAs TO BE
OBSERVED STRICTLY)**

AMAs are requested to submit applications for renewal at least 3 months before the date of expiry of the present term. The CGEWCC reserves the right to delete any name due to non-receipt of application for renewal in time.

AMAs are requested not to prescribe medicines for more than $\frac{3}{4}$ days at a time. However, in case of $\frac{3}{4}$ consultations, the treatment should be restricted to maximum period of ten days. The fees for consultation and injection should be taken as per GI, M.H., O.M. No. S-14025/10/2010-MS, dated 17-3-2011 of Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (Department of Health), New Delhi.

Any change in address / degree, etc. should be intimated immediately with documentary evidence. In case of death of AMA, an intimation has to be sent to the Secretary, CGEWCC, Kolkata by the nearest relative of the AMA with a copy of death certificate.

**Recognition of Johal Multispeciality Hospital, Hoshiarpur Road,
Ramamandi, Jalandhar, Punjab for treatment of Central Government
employees under CS (MA) Rules, 1944**

The undersigned is directed to say that the proposal received for recognition of Johal Multispeciality Hospital, Jalandhar (Punjab) for treatment of Central Government Employees and their family members under CS (MA) Rules, 1944 was under consideration.

2. In view of the hardship faced by CS (MA) beneficiaries for their own treatment and the treatment of their family members at Jalandhar (Punjab), the matter has been examined in the Ministry and it has been decided to empanel Johal Multispeciality Hospital, Jalandhar (Punjab) under Central Services (Medical Attendance) Rules, 1944.

3. The Schedule of charges for the treatment of Central Government Employees and the members of their family under the CS (MA) Rules, 1944, will be the rates fixed for CGHS, Chandigarh. The approved rates are available on the website of CGHS (www.mohfw.nic.in//eghs.html) and may be downloaded / printed.

4. The undersigned is further directed to clarify as under:—

(a) "Package Rate" shall mean and include lump sum cost of in-patient treatment / day care / diagnostic procedure for which a CS (MA) beneficiary has been permitted by the competent authority or for treatment under emergency from the time of admission to the time of discharge, including (but not limited to)-(i) Registration charges, (ii) Admission charges, (iii) Accommodation charges including patient's diet, (iv) Operation charges, (v) Injection charges, (vi) Dressing charges, (vii) Doctor / consultant visit charges, (viii) ICU/CCU charges, (ix) Monitoring charges, (x) Transfusion charges, (xi) Anaesthesia charges, (xii) Operation theatre charges, (xiii) Procedural charges / Surgeon's fee, (xiv) Cost of surgical disposables and all sundries used during hospitalization, (xv) Cost of medicines, (xvi) Related routine and essential investigations, (xvii) Physiotherapy charges etc, (xviii) Nursing care and charges for its services.

(b) Cost of Implants is reimbursable in addition to package rates as per CGHS ceiling rates for implants or as per actual, in case there is no CGHS prescribed ceiling rates.

(c) Treatment charges for new born baby are separately reimbursable in addition to delivery charges for mother.

(d) Johal Multispeciality Hospital, Jalandhar (Punjab) shall not charge more than the package rates fixed for CGHS, Chandigarh.

(e) Expenses on toiletries, cosmetics, telephone bills, etc. are not reimbursable and are not included in package rates.

5. Package rates envisage duration of indoor treatment as follows:—

- Up to 12 days : for Specialized (Super Specialities) treatment
Up to 7 days : for other Major Surgeries
Up to 3 days : for Laparoscopic surgeries / normal Deliveries
1 day : for day care / Minor (OPD) surgeries.

No additional charge on account of extended period of stay shall be allowed if that extension is due to infection on the consequences of surgical procedure or due to any improper procedure and is not justified.

In case, there are no CGHS prescribed rates for any test / procedure, then AIIMS rates are applicable. If there are no AIIMS rates, then reimbursement is to be arrived at by calculating admissible amount item-wise (e.g. room rent, investigations, cost of medicines, procedure charges, etc), as per approved rates / actually, in case of investigations.

6. (a) CS (MA) beneficiaries are entitled to facilities of private, semi-private or general ward depending on their basic pay. The entitlement is as follows:—

S. No.	Pay drawn in pay band	Ward Entitlement
1.	Up to ₹ 13,950	General Ward
2.	₹ 13,960 to 19,530	Semi-Private Ward
3.	₹ 19,540 and above	Private Ward

(b) The package rates given in rate list are for semi-private ward.

(c) The package rates prescribed are for semi-private ward. If the beneficiary is entitled for general ward, there will be a decrease of 10% in the rates; for private ward entitlement there will be an increase of 15%. However, the rates shall be same for investigation irrespective of entitlement, whether the patient is admitted or not and the test, *per se*, does not require admission.

7. The hospital shall charge from the beneficiary as per the CGHS prescribed rates or its own rate list, whichever is lower. The hospital shall charge CGHS NABH Chandigarh rates till the expiry of its accreditation i.e., up to June, 05, 2016. If the NABH accreditation of the hospital will be renewed and continued after 5-6-2016, the Hospital will charge NABH rates; otherwise they will charge non-NABH CGHS Chandigarh rates after 5-6-2016.

8. (a) The maximum room rent admissible for different categories would be:—

General ward	₹ 1,000 per day
Semi-private ward	₹ 2,000 per day
Private ward	₹ 3,000 per day
Day care (6 to 8 Hrs.)	₹ 500 (same for all categories)

(b) Room rent mentioned above at (a) above is applicable only for treatment procedures for which there is no CGHS prescribed package rate.

Room rent will include charges for occupation of bed, diet for the patient, charges for water and electricity supply, linen charges, nursing charges and routine upkeeping.

(c) During the treatment in ICCU/ICU, no separate room rent will be admissible.

(d) Private ward is defined as a hospital room where single patient is accommodated and which has an attached toilet (lavatory and bath). The room should have furnishings like wardrobe, dressing table, bed-side table, sofa set, etc., as well as a bed for attendant. The room has to be air-conditioned.

(e) Semi Private ward is defined as a hospital room where two to three patients are accommodated and which has attached toilet facilities and necessary furnishings.

(f) General ward is defined as hall that accommodates four to ten patients.

(g) Normally the treatment in higher category of accommodation than the entitled category is not permissible. However, in case of an emergency when the entitled category accommodation is not available, admission in the immediate higher category may be allowed till the entitled category accommodation becomes available. However, if a particular hospital does not have the ward as per entitlement of beneficiary, then the hospital can only bill as per entitlement of the beneficiary even though the treatment was given in higher type of ward.

If, on the request of the beneficiary, treatment is provided in a higher category of ward, then the expenditure over and above entitlement will have to be borne by the beneficiary.

9. In case of non-emergencies, the beneficiary shall have the option of availing specific treatment / investigation from any of the above mentioned hospitals of his/her choice (provided the hospital is recognized for that treatment procedure / test), after the specific treatment / investigation has been advised by Authorized Medical Attendant and on production of valid ID card and permission letter from his/her concerned Ministry / Department.

10. The hospital shall honour permission letter issued by competent authority and provide treatment / investigation facilities as specified in the permission letter.

11. The hospital shall also provide treatment / investigation facilities to the CGHS beneficiaries and their eligible dependent family members at their own rates or rates approved under CS (MA) Rules, whichever is lower. The hospital shall provide treatment to such pensioner CGHS beneficiaries after authentication through verification of valid CGHS Cards.

12. However, pensioner CGHS beneficiaries would make payment for the medical treatment at approved rates as mentioned above and submit the medical reimbursement claim to the Addl. Director, CGHS through the CMO i/c of the CGHS Wellness Centre, where the CGHS Card of the beneficiary is registered.

13. In case of emergencies, the beneficiary shall have the option of availing specific treatment / investigation from any of the above mentioned hospitals of his/her choice (provided the hospital is recognised for that treatment procedure / test), on production of valid ID card, issued by Competent Authority.

14. During the in-patient treatment of the CS (MA) beneficiary, the Hospital will not ask the beneficiary or his attendant to purchase separately the medicines / sundries / equipment or accessories from outside and will provide the treatment within the package rate, fixed by the CGHS which includes the cost of all the items.

15. In case of treatment taken in emergency in any non-recognized private hospitals, reimbursement shall be considered by competent authority at CGHS prescribed Package / rates only.

16. If one or more minor procedures form part of a major treatment procedure, then package charges would be permissible for major procedure and only 50% of charges for minor procedure.

17. Any legal liability arising out of such services shall be the sole responsibility and shall be dealt with by the concerned empanelled hospital. Services will be provided by the Hospital as per the terms given above.

18. Ministry of Health and Family Welfare reserves the right to withdraw / cancel the above recognition without assigning any reason.

19. The order takes effect from the date of issue of the O.M.

20. The authorities of Johal Multispeciality Hospital, Jalandhar (Punjab) will have to enter into an agreement with the Government of India to the effect that the Hospital will charge from the Central Government employees at the rates fixed by the Government and they will have to sign a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) (2 copies enclosed only for Hospital) within a period of 3 months from the date of issue of the above mentioned OM failing which the Hospital will be derecognized. Subject to above, the Hospital can start treating Central Government employees covered under CS (MA) Rules, 1944.

Risk Allowance to Central Government employees- Clarification

Reference is invited to this Department's O.M No. 21012/01/2008-Estt. (Allowance), dated the 18th June, 2012 wherein the grant of Risk allowance was extended at the then existing rated beyond 30-06.2012 and up to 31.12.2012. Subsequently vide this Department's O.M no. 21012/01/2010-Estt, (Allowance), dated the 18th October, 2012, the rates of Risk Allowance were revised with effect from 1st September, 2008, implying that grant of Risk Allowance would be at revised rates with effect from 1st September, 2008 onwards, Hence, there is no need for issuing separate instructions continuing payment of Risk Allowance beyond 31.12.2012.

Eligibility of widowed/ divorced daughters for grant of family
pension- Clarification.

Provisions for grant of family pension to a widowed/divorced daughter beyond the age of 25 years has been made vide OM, dated 30.08.2004. This provision has been included in Clause (iii) of sub-rule 54 (6) of the CCS (Pension), Rules, 1972. for settlement of old cases, it was clarified, vide OM, dated 28.04.2011, that the family pension may be granted to eligible widowed/divorced daughters with effect from 30.08.2004, in case the death of the Government Servant/ Pensioner occurred before this date.

2. This Department has been receiving communications from various Ministries / Departments seeking clarification regarding eligibility of a daughter who became widowed/ divorced after the death of the employee / pensioner.

3. As indicated in Rule 54 (8) of the CCS (Pension) Rules, 1972, the turn of unmarried children below 25 years of age comes after the death or remarriage of their mother / father, i.e., the pensioner and his/her spouse. Thereafter, the family pension is payable to the disabled children for life and then to the unmarried / widowed / divorced daughters above the age of 25 years.

4. It is clarified that the family pension is payable to the children as they are considered to be dependent on the Government servant / pensioner or his/her spouse. A child who is not earning equal to or more than the sum of minimum family pension and dearness relief thereon is considered to be dependent on his/her parents. Therefore, only those children who are dependent and meet other conditions of eligibility for family pension at the time of death of the Government servant or his/her spouse, whichever is later, are eligible for family pension. If two or more children are eligible for family pension at that time, family pension will be payable to each child on his/her turn, provided he/she is still eligible for family pension when the turn comes. Similarly, family pension to a widowed / divorced daughter is payable, provided she fulfils all eligibility conditions at the time of death / ineligibility of her parents and on the date her turn to receive family pension comes.

5. As regards opening of old cases, a daughter, if eligible, as explained in the preceding paragraph, may be granted family pension with effect from 30th August, 2004. The position is illustrated through an example. Shri A, a pensioner, died in 1986. He was survived by his wife, Smt. B, a son Shri C and a daughter, Kumari D, the daughter being the younger. Kumari D married in 1990 and got widowed in 1996. Smt. B died in 2001. Thereafter, Shri C was getting family pension, being disabled, and died in 2003. Thereafter, the family pension was stopped as Kumari D was not eligible for it at that time. She applied for family pension on the basis of OM., dated 30th August, 2004. Since she was a widow and had no independent source of income at the time of death of her mother and on the date her turn came, she may be granted family pension. The family pension will continue only till she remarries or starts earning her livelihood equal to or more than the sum of minimum family pension and dearness relief thereon.

6. This is only a clarification and the entitlement of widowed / divorced daughters would continue to be determined in terms of OM, dated 25 / 30th August, 2004, read with OM, dated 28-4-2011.



Disclosure of personal information under the RTI Act, 2005

The Central Information Commission in one of its decisions (*copy enclosed — not printed*) has held that information about the complaint made against an officer of the Government and any possible action the authorities might have taken on those complaints, qualifies as personal information within the meaning of provision of Section 8 (1) (j) of the RTI Act, 2005.

2. The Central Information Commission while deciding the said case has cited the decision of Supreme Court of India in the matter of *Girish R. Deshpande v. CIC and others* (SLP (C) No. 27734/2012) in which it was held as under:—

“The performance of an employee / Officer in an organization is primarily a matter between the employee and the employer and normally those aspects are governed by the service rules which fall under the expression ‘personal information’, the disclosure of which has no relationship to any public activity or public interest. On the other hand, the disclosure of which could cause unwarranted invasion of the privacy of that individual.” The Supreme Court further held that such information could be disclosed only if it would serve a larger public interest.



Extension of CGHS facilities to permanently disabled dependent brother of a CGHS beneficiary

The undersigned is directed to state that dependent brother of a Central Government employee is presently entitled for CGHS coverage up to the age of becoming a major. Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has been receiving requests from CGHS beneficiaries for removal of the upper age-limit in the case of disabled dependent brother so as to provide them the CGHS facilities without any age limit as has been provided to disabled son of a CGHS beneficiary.

2. Accordingly, with a view to assuage the hardship, it has been decided to extend the CGHS facilities to permanently disabled dependent brother of a CGHS beneficiary, without any age-limit.

3. For availing CGHS facilities under this provision, the permanently disabled dependent brother of a CGHS beneficiary must be suffering from, any one or more of the disabilities as defined in Section 2 (i) of The persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995 (No. 1 of 1996) which includes:—

- (i) Blindness
- (ii) Low-vision
- (iii) Leprosy-cured
- (iv) Hearing impairment
- (v) Locomotor disability
- (vi) Mental retardation
- (vii) Mental illness

and as per Clause (j) of Section 2 of National Trust for Welfare of Persons with Autism, Cerebral Palsy, Mental Retardation and Multiple Disabilities Act, 1999 (No. 44 of 1999), which presently covers a person suffering from any of the condition relating to autism, cerebral palsy, mental retardation or a combination of any two or more of such conditions and includes a person suffering from severe multiple disability. It is clarified that 'permanent disability' means a person with 40% or more of one or more disabilities.

4. The eligibility criteria for a permanently disabled dependent brother to avail medical facilities under CGHS will be as under:—

- (a) He must be wholly dependent on the principal CGHS cardholder beneficiary.
- (b) He should be unmarried and should not have his own family.
- (c) The income limit for deciding dependency shall be as prescribed by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare from time to time and as applicable in CGHS for the time being in force.
- (d) He must be ordinarily residing with the primary CGHS cardholder beneficiary.
- (e) All the above conditions are required to be fulfilled for availing CGHS facilities. The CGHS facilities will cease to exist with immediate effect if any one of the above conditions is violated.

This office memorandum will be effective from the date of issue.

Approval for Photo Selective Vaporization of Prostate (PVP) Surgery using Green Light HPS Fibre (Angled Delivery Device) to be used with HPS Laser System 120 watt (AMS) under CGHS / CS (MA) Rules

With reference to the above-mentioned subject, the undersigned is directed to state that this Ministry has been receiving requests for grant of permission for Green Light HPS laser fibre for Laser Prostatectomy. The matter has been examined in consultation with specialists in the field and it has now been decided to permit Photo Selective Vaporization of Prostate (PVP) Surgery using Green Light HPS Fibre (Angled Delivery Device) to be used with HPS Laser System 120 watt (AMS) under CGHS/CS (MA) Rules on the recommendations of a Government Specialist in the following conditions:

- (a) Patients on anti-coagulants, which cannot be withdrawn even for a short duration
- (b) Patients suffering from bleeding diathesis.
- (c) Patients with large prostate gland, weighing more than 60-80 gm.
- (d) Patients with CCF and renal failure, where fluid overload is to be avoided.

In other BHP cases, the standard line of treatment shall be TURP.

2. The ceiling rate of Green Light HPS Fibre (Angled Delivery Device) to be used with HPS Laser System 120 watt (AMS) for reimbursement / approval under CGHS / CS (MA) patients shall be ₹ 65,000 (incl. of all taxes) or actual, whichever is lower. The ceiling rate shall be effective for one year or till further order, whichever is earlier.

3. CGHS Package rate for surgery shall be the same as for Holmium Laser prostatectomy and the cost of Green Light HPS Fibre (Angled Delivery Device) shall be permitted in addition, as per the above prescribed ceiling rate or actual, whichever is lower.

**Suspension of empanelment of 'Saket City Hospital, New Delhi'
from the list of Hospitals / Centres empanelled under CGHS**

The undersigned is directed to state that CGHS has empanelled private hospitals in various CGHS covered cities to provide inpatient healthcare facilities to its beneficiaries. Empanelment of the private hospitals is done under a contractual agreement between the Government of India and the private hospital on mutually agreed terms and conditions.

2. This Ministry has received a number of complaints against Saket City Hospital (formerly-Gujar Mal Modi Hospital and Research Centre), Saket, New Delhi regarding deficiency in services ranging from denial of credit facilities and overcharging to ill-treatment, harassment and rude behaviour by staff / doctors to CGHS beneficiaries. The issues raised by the beneficiaries have been viewed seriously by this Ministry as it tantamount to violation of the terms and conditions of empanelment as laid down in the 'Memorandum of Agreement'.

3. A 'Show Cause Notice' was issued to Saket City Hospital seeking clarifications on the grievances raised by the beneficiaries. However, the reply received from Saket City Hospital has not been found satisfactory.

4. It has, therefore been decided to suspend the CGHS empanelment of Saket City Hospital, New Delhi with immediate effect, for a period of one year or till further orders, whichever is earlier. The hospital shall no longer be a part of the list of empanelled hospitals / centres for any purposes under CGHS. Patients already admitted prior to the issue of this OM, shall be provided treatment and discharged within seven days from the date of issue of this OM. However, in respect of the patients who remain admitted beyond seven days, their bills would be accepted only on submission of the proper justification for stay.

5. This OM shall be effective from the date of its issue.

**Submission of Form 14 by the spouse to the pension
disbursing bank after the death of the pensioner**

The undersigned is directed to draw attention to the requirement of applying for family pension in Form 14 as given in Rule 81 (2) (A) (ii) of the CCS (Pension) Rules, 1972.

2. This Department has been receiving representations from various quarters to do away with the condition of applying for family pension in Form 14 as it is causing inconvenience to widows, who find it difficult and embarrassing to present themselves before two Gazetted Officers / persons of repute for attestation of Form 14.

3. Before commencement of family pension, personal identification details of the spouse such as specimen signature, personal mark of identification and left hand thumb impression, proof of age / date of birth of spouse and an undertaking from him/her for recovery of excess payment are to be obtained by the bank. Form 14 serves as a standard processing sheet, which defines and delineates the exact requirement of information to be given to the Pension Disbursing Bank. It was apprehended that in the absence of this standard, the widows may be asked to submit any relevant or irrelevant information by the bank. This could also lead to delay in commencement of the family pension.

4. The matter has been examined and it has been agreed that in case the pensioner and spouse are holding a joint account, the possibility of claim for family pension from someone else does not arise. Therefore, in such cases, there is no requirement of Form 14. The spouse may inform the Bank of death of the pensioner and request the bank for commencement of family pension, through a simple letter. He/she may enclose a copy of death certificate of pensioner, PPO, proof of his/her own age / date of birth and an undertaking for recovery of excess payment. In other cases, i.e., where the pension is not being credited to the joint bank account of the pensioner and his/her spouse, Form 14 will be continued to be obtained by the banks. However, the condition of attestation of Form 14 has been done away with and witnessing by two persons has been considered as sufficient.

5. For all future cases, Head of Office will forward to the PAO, along with similar details for the pensioner, the specimen signature, personal mark of identification, left hand thumb impression, the proof of age / date of birth and an undertaking from the spouse regarding recovery of excess payment. After the death of the pensioner, the spouse of the deceased pensioner will be required to provide only death certificate to the paying bank, who will identify the spouse based on the information given in the PPO and its own "Know Your Customer" procedures. Where the pensioner and his/her spouse do not have a joint account, Form 14 will be required as in Para. 4 above.

Subject : Grant of Dearness Relief to Central Government pensioners/family pensioners – Revised rate effective from 1.7.2013.

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's OM No. 42/13/2012-P&PW(G) dated 2nd May, 2013 on the subject mentioned above and to state that the President is pleased to decide that the Dearness Relief (DR) payable to Central Government pensioners/family pensioners shall be enhanced from the existing rate of 80 % to 90% w.e.f. 1st July, 2013.

2. These orders apply to (i) All Civilian Central Government Pensioners/Family Pensioners (ii) The Armed Forces Pensioners, Civilian Pensioners paid out of the Defence Service Estimates, (iii) All India Service Pensioners (iv) Railway Pensioners and (v) The Burma Civilian pensioners/family pensioners and pensioners/families of displaced Government pensioners from Pakistan, who are Indian Nationals but receiving pension on behalf of Government of Pakistan and are in receipt of ad-hoc ex-gratia allowance of Rs. 3500/- p.m. in terms of this Department's OM No. 23/1/97-P&PW(B) dated 23.2.1998 read with this Department's OM No. 23/3/2008-P&PW(B) dated 15.9.2008.

3. Central Government Employees who had drawn lump sum amount on absorption in a PSU/Autonomous body and have become eligible to restoration of 1/3rd commuted portion of pension as well as revision of the restored amount in terms of this Department's OM No. 4/59/97-P&PW (D) dated 14.07.1998 will also be entitled to the payment of DR @ 90% w.e.f. 1.7.2013 on full pension i.e. the revised pension which the absorbed employee would have received on the date of restoration had he not drawn lump sum payment on absorption and Dearness Pension subject to fulfillment of the conditions laid down in para 5 of the O.M. dated 14.07.98. In this connection, instructions contained in this Department's OM No.4/29/99-P&PW (D) dated. 12.7.2000 refer.

4. Payment of DR involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.

5. Other provisions governing grant of DR in respect of employed family pensioners and re-employed Central Government Pensioners will be regulated in accordance with the provisions contained in this Department's OM No. 45/73/97-P&PW (G) dated 2.7.1999 as amended vide this Department's OM No. F. No. 38/88/2008-P&PW(G) dated 9th July, 2009. The provisions relating to regulation of DR where a pensioner is in receipt of more than one pension, will remain unchanged.

6. In the case of retired Judges of the Supreme Court and High Courts, necessary orders will be issued by the Department of Justice separately.

7. It will be the responsibility of the pension disbursing authorities, including the nationalized banks, etc. to calculate the quantum of DR payable in each individual case.

8. The offices of Accountant General and Authorised Public Sector Banks are requested to arrange payment of relief to pensioners etc. on the basis of these instructions without waiting for any further instructions from the Comptroller and Auditor General of India and the Reserve Bank of India in view of letter No. 528-TA, II/34-80-II dated 23/04/1981 of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India addressed to all Accountant Generals and Reserve Bank of India Circular No. GANB No. 2958/GA-64 (ii) (CGL)/81 dated the 21st May, 1981 addressed to State Bank of India and its subsidiaries and all Nationalised Banks.

9. In their application to the pensioners/family pensioners belonging to Indian Audit and Accounts Department, these orders issue after consultation with the C&AG.

Rotation of officials working in sensitive posts

Central Vigilance Commission and the Department of Personnel and Training have issued instructions for effecting rotational transfers of officials posted on sensitive posts. As per Commission's instructions issued *vide* Letter Nos. 98/VGL/60, dated 15-4-1999, 2-11-2001 and 004/VGL/90, dated 1-5-2008 and 4-1-2012 (for public sector banks) on this issue, it was prescribed that Ministries / Departments / Organizations and CVOs are to identify the sensitive posts and staff working in these posts and also ensure that they are strictly rotated after every two / three years to avoid developing vested interests.

2. The Commission in the superintendence of vigilance administration over the years has observed that such rotational transfers are not effected in many organizations due to which officials continue to remain in the same posts for long periods. Such overstay and continuous postings afford scope for indulging in corrupt activities, developing vested interests etc., which may not be in the interest of the organization. The Commission would, therefore, emphasize that periodical rotation of officials holding sensitive posts / jobs needs to be ensured. As such, officials should not be retained in the same place / position for long by the Ministries / Departments / PSUs / Banks / Organizations, etc.

3. Heads / CVOs of all Departments / Organizations are advised to ensure strict compliance of the Commission's guidelines and implement the same in letter and spirit. Further, the CVOs should specifically report the action taken indicating the number of officials rotated / transferred in the respective organizations in the Monthly Report of CVOs submitted to the Commission.

Extending the facility of e-IPO for payment of RTI fee in Indian Missions by 'Indian citizens abroad'

A service called eIPO(Electronic Indian Postal Order) was launched with effect from 22-3-2013 to facilitate Indian citizens abroad across the globe to purchase an e-IPO by paying the fee online to access the information under the RTI Act, 2005 from the Central Public authorities.

2. The procedure to obtain e-IPO has already been explained vide this Department's Office Memorandum of even number, dated 22-3-2013. The main points of the procedure are as under

- (a) The user needs to get himself registered at either <http://www.epostoffice.gov.in> or www.indiapost.gov.in.
- (b) He has to select the Ministry / Department from whom he desires to seek the information under the RTI Act and the e-IPO so generated, by making payment using Debit or Credit card, can be used to seek information from that Ministry / Department only.
- (c) A printout of the e-IPO is required to be attached with the RTI application. If the RTI application is being filed electronically, e-IPO is required to be attached as an attachment.

(d) This facility is only for purchasing an Indian Postal Order electronically. All the requirements for filing an RTI application as well as other provisions regarding eligibility, time-limit, exemptions etc., as provided in the RTI Act, 2005 will continue to apply.

3. It has been brought to the notice of this Department that Indian citizens living abroad are facing difficulties in payment of fees for accessing information from Indian Missions / Posts abroad as the facility of e-IPO was not available with them.

4. In order to facilitate for obtaining the information under the RTI Act, 2005 by the Indian citizen living abroad from Indian Missions / Posts under Ministry of External Affairs, the facility of e-IPO is extended to 176 Indian Missions / Posts. List is enclosed.

Levy of Agency Commission etc., by M/s. Balmer Lawrie and Company Limited on air tickets booked on Government account

The undersigned is directed to say that this Department has been receiving references seeking clarification whether agency commission / service charge / processing fee, etc., levied by M/s Balmer Lawrie and Company Limited (BLCL) on air tickets booked on Government account from April, 2013 onwards are to be paid to BLCL or not. Since the matter is still under consideration, all Ministries / Departments / Government Offices are hereby advised **not to pay the commission, etc.,** charged by BLCL in their Bills, raised for air tickets booked on Government account, **till a final decision is taken in the matter.**

2. Guidelines on air travel on Tours/ Transfers/LTC, etc have been issued by Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance from time to time. Latest such instructions were issued vide this Department O.M No. 19024/1/2009-E-IV dated 16.09.2010. One of the important conditions prescribed in these guidelines relate to availing the services of authorized travel agents. These guidelines inter alia either directly from Air India/ Airlines (Booking counters/ Offices/ website) or if services of any travel agent is to be availed of, then air tickets may be procured only from M/s Balmer Lawrie and Company Limited (BLCL), M/s Ashok Travels And Tours (ATT) and Indian Railways Catering and Tourism Corporation Ltd. (IRCTC) [to the extent IRCTC is authorized as per DoPT's O.M No. 31011/6/2002-Estt (A), dated 2-12-2009. However, repeated references are being received in this Department seeking relaxation of these guidelines for settlement of Bills of TA/LTC claims, Mostly on the grounds that the officials concerned were unaware of these guidelines and hence they procured air tickets from unauthorized travel agents. All Ministries/ Departments are again advised to ensure strict compliance of the guidelines on booking of air ticket on Government account, by all concerned, and if need be, re-circulate these guidelines within all the offices under its administrative control.
